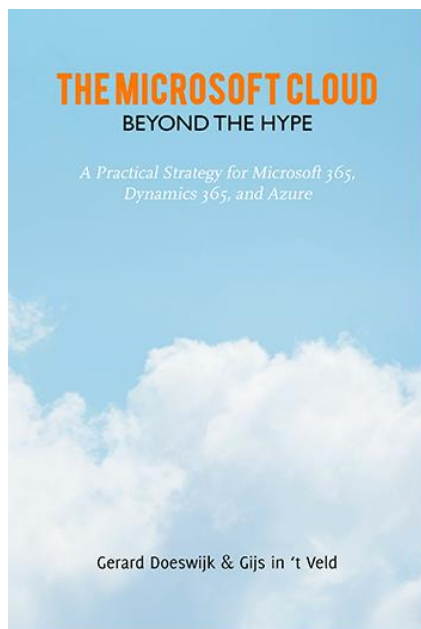


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Gerard Doeswijk & Gijs in 't Veld - The Microsoft Cloud: Beyond the Hype

In the last decade or so, Microsoft's cloud services have undergone significant transformations. Microsoft's presence in the cloud domain was not as pronounced until the launch of Office 365 in 2011.

Now Office 365 has evolved into Microsoft 365, and its online business productivity services, combined with Dynamics 365 and Azure, have compelling advantages for business users, developers, security professionals, and IT administrators. Microsoft's cloud offerings have gained significant traction, and the company is now considered "the" major player in the cloud industry serving businesses and the public sector in every domain.

Since their previous books together CIOs, CTOs, CFOs, and other industry peers have continued to seek guidance from the authors on cloud adoption

strategies to drive value and adoption for their cloud investments. Either to embrace the cloud due to the diminishing returns on their existing IT investments, or to address the regulatory, compliance and financial challenges they face.
